



A.S. Leader of the Month Application

The A.S. Leader of the Month is a student leader who proudly represents Associated Students through their commitment to the organization, embodying A.S. values (professional development, campus community, communication, advocacy, shared governance, service, diversity, and sustainability), the betterment of campus culture, and enhancing A.S morale.

No more than one member from each A.S. board, committee or commission can be nominated per month. A completed nomination packet must be received no later than the third week of each month to the Government Affairs Office. The Awards Committee shall take all nominations into consideration and shall make all final decisions.

CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS:

- Only SDSU students who have not been selected previously in the same academic year are eligible.
- Students can only be nominated by one A.S. board, committee or commission per month.
- Candidates must be an active, voting member of the nominating board, committee or commission they are nominated by.
