ACADEMIC/ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS
(See attached Application)

Six scholarships will be awarded each year (three per semester) to qualified and eligible applicants who meet the following academic and eligibility requirements:

ACADEMIC/ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must be a current A.S. part-time employee*, and in good standing.
2. Applicant must carry a minimum of six (6) units at San Diego State University, in the current and following semester.
3. Applicant **must have completed** four months by opening of the filing period as an A.S. employee (need not be continuous), but must be within the last three years. The filing period begins Friday, November 13, 2020.
4. Student must have an overall GPA of 2.75 or in the absence of 2.75, a 3.0 in the last 24 units of work.
5. Applicant must complete and file application by 4:30pm deadline.
6. An employee is eligible for one scholarship per academic year. (i.e.: an employee who was awarded a fall A.S. Scholarship will be ineligible to apply for spring.)
7. We encourage all eligible employees to apply. Foremost consideration will be given to undergraduates and employees who have never received an A.S. Scholarship.
8. A thank you letter written to the Associated Students is required.

EVALUATION WILL BE BASED UPON ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT, ESSAY, CAMPUS AND COMMUNITY CONTRIBUTION, FINANCIAL NEED & LONGEVITY OF A.S. EMPLOYMENT.

Applications will be screened by a work group, who may not be scholarship applicants, with consultation of a non-member scholarship expert. Scholarships will be awarded once each semester after an appropriate filing and review period.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE CLOSING DATE, FRIDAY, DECEMBER 4, 2020.

Scholarships will be awarded at respective division end of semester meetings/parties.

***Definition of A.S. part-time employee: Part-time employee or work-study. Excludes volunteers.**

ACADEMIC/ELIGIBILITY

REQUIREMENTS: In order to qualify for an Associated Students scholarship, you must have a 2.75 overall GPA, or in the absence of a 2.75, a 3.0 in the last 24 units of work; must have been employed by the Associated Students a minimum of four months; a current SDSU student in the current and following semester. An employee is eligible for one scholarship per academic year. Foremost consideration will be given to undergraduates and employees who have never received an A.S. Scholarship. A scholarship may not be used concurrently with the Fee Reimbursement Program. Applicants will be judged equally on academic achievement, essay, and campus/community contributions. A thank you letter written to the Associated Students is required.
