Student Health Services Fee Increase Approved by AS, CAL In Support

On October 27, 2010, Associated Students Council voted to support the \$65 fee increase proposed by the Department of Student Health Services. According to Thomas Wilson, interim director of SHS, the fee was proposed because Student Health Services has been losing money over the last couple of years due to a difficult economy, rising cost of healthcare, and decreased student enrollment.

Student Health Services provides low cost medical care and medications to SDSU students. These services range from basic check-ups to lab work to x-rays to psychological services.

On October 11, the CAL Council was given a presentation on the fee, its history, and its purpose; the council voted to support the increase on October 18. The fee will go into effect Spring 2011.

From October 6 through October 22nd, San Diego State participated in College Rocks Hunger, a program in which San Diego universities compete to gather food to give to the San Diego community food banks. The food drive, organized by Associated Students Vice President of Finance Amanda Pascoe, raised over 18,000 pounds for local food banks. SDSU contributed approximately 70% of the total amount of food raised between all of the participating universities, making this

the third year in a row that SDSU has won the competition. The prize is an electric guitar that will be engraved and hung up in the Government Affairs Office.
